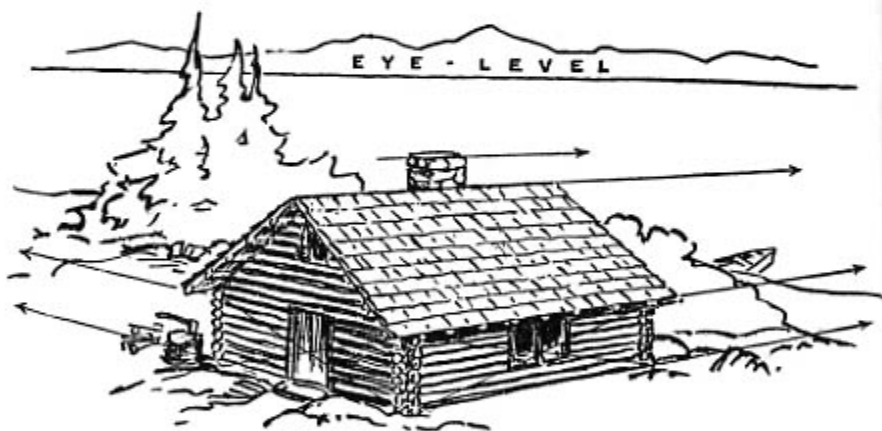




Fold a piece of cardboard and place it on the brick.
This makes a house.

Draw it in perspective.

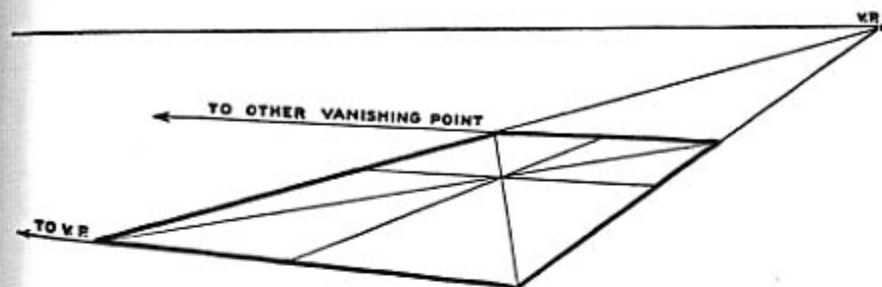
The point of the roof is directly above where the two end lines cross.



There is a door at the center of the end and a window at the center of the side.

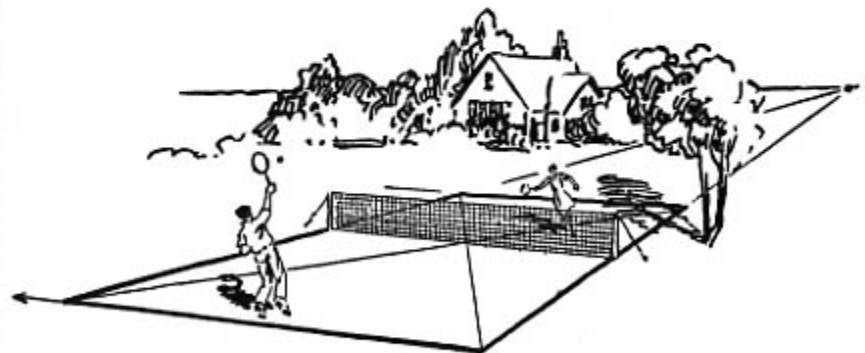
These are determined by the crosslines or intersecting diagonals.

THE USE OF DIAGONALS



Sketch the top of the brick omitting the sides and showing the crosslines and the dividing lines going to the vanishing points.

A rectangle or square divided in this manner has a great number of uses in drawing.
