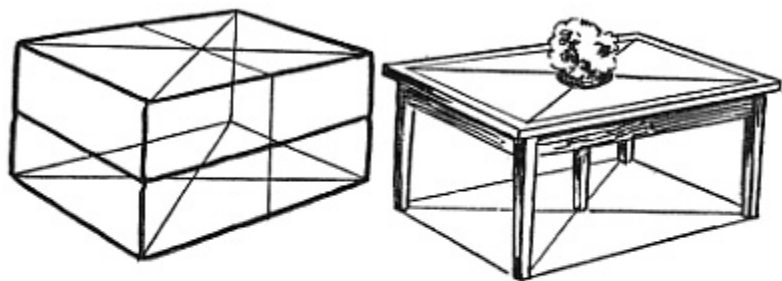
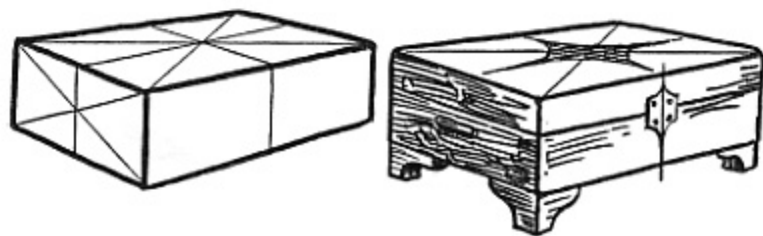
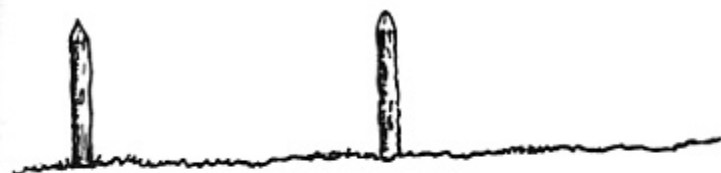


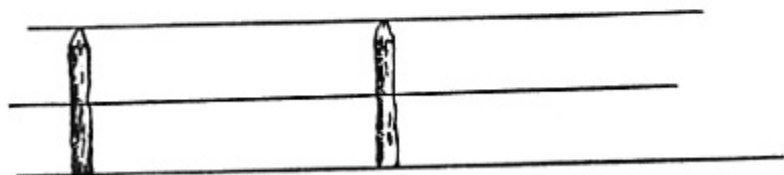
The top of the brick has crosslines. Lines drawn through the center point to either vanishing point divide the brick in halves.



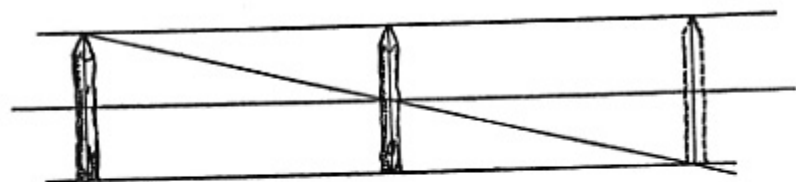
Bricks with crosslines can be used as a basis for a large number of our perspective drawings.



We have two posts the same height.



We now draw three parallel lines: one along the top, one through the center, and one along the base of the posts.



Now if we draw a line from the top of the first post straight through the center of the second post we discover that it meets the base line where the third post should be.
